

Smithtown Stitchers Block of the Month 2020
Blocks 3 and 4 Due at April 20 Guild Meeting
Baskets and Flowers

Tulip Blocks

Background: Cut 8 @ 4 ½" square
Cut 5 @ 3 ½" square
Cut 20 @ 1 ½" square (optional: use a contrast as leaves)

Accent Center: Cut 5 @ 3 ½" square

Main Flower: Cut 10 @ 3 ¼" square
Cut 10 @ 2 ½" x 4 ½"

1. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of the lighter of your 3 ½" squares. Place Background and Accent Center 3 ½" squares right sides together and stitch 1/4" on each side of drawn diagonal. Cut apart on diagonal and press.
2. Place 3 ¼" Main Flower square on top of each half square triangle from step 1, right sides together. Draw a diagonal in OPPOSITE direction of the seam. Sew ¼" on both sides of drawn diagonal. Cut apart on the diagonal and trim to 2 ½" squares, being careful to center diagonal seam.
3. Place 2 of your squares from step 2 right sides together, matching the accent centers. Sew ¼" seam along accent center, press
4. Draw a diagonal on all 1 ½" squares. Place these right sides together in the lower corner of each 2 ½" x 4 ½" Main flower rectangle. Stitch ON drawn diagonal line, trim excess fabric, flip and press.
5. Assemble as shown:



Make 2 blocks. Each block should measure 12 ½" square.
