

Smithtown Stitchers 2020 Block of the Month

Flower #3 – due at the November Meeting (?)

For ONE flower

Use your favorite method to make (4) 2 ½" Half Square Triangles (HST) using your flower fabric and background fabric.

Cut (4) 2" squares of background fabric and mark diagonal on wrong side

Cut (4) 1" squares of flower center fabric and mark diagonal on wrong side.

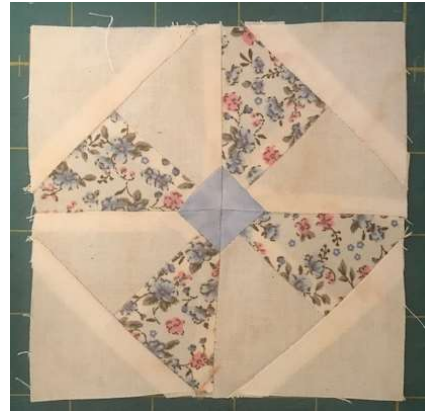
Place the 2" square over a corner of each HST, stitch ON the diagonal, and trim to ¼" seam

Very Important: be sure to place 2" squares over the same corner of each HST.

Place the 1" square on the OPPOSITE corner of each HST, stitch on the diagonal, trim to ¼" seam and press. *Hint: press 2 seams towards center and 2 seams away from center to reduce bulk.*

Assemble each flower as shown in the diagrams.





NOTE: Each block needs (5) 4 ½" square flowers and (4) 4 ½" squares of background fabric.

Assemble block as shown below:



Notes:

Block measures 12 ½" unfinished.

Make 2 blocks to complete 12 blocks for your quilt top.
