

Block of the Month July/August
Eleanor Roosevelt

Each 12 ½" block is made up of (32) 2 ½" (unfinished) Half Square Triangles (HST) and (4) 2 ½" corner squares. These directions yield 2 blocks

Using Go Cutter

Cut: (1) 8" square of corner fabric

Cut on #55099 this will yield 9 squares (only need 8)

Cut (2) Background fabric @ 7" x 8"

(2) Corner fabric @ 7" x 8"

Place one Background fabric right side together with Corner fabric twice

Cut on #55063 Yields 24 HST

Cut (3) Background fabric @ 7" x 8"

Cut (3) V fabrics @ 7" x 8"

Place one Background fabric right side together with V fabric three times

Cut on # 55063 Yields 36 HST You need 32 total

Cut (1) background fabric 5 ½" x 7"

Cut (1) Center fabric 5 ½" x 7"

Place one background fabric right side together with Center fabric

Place on #55063 covering 2/3 of the die to yield 8 HST

Using Rotary Cutter

Cut (8) squares @ 2 ½ inches for the corners

Using your favorite method, make the following 2 ½" (unfinished) HST:

(24) HST using same fabric of corner squares/background

(32) HST using V fabric/background

(8) HST using center fabric/background

Assemble block in rows following diagram:
