

Smithtown Stitchers

Block of the Month #6 due November 2018

Directions using Rotary Cutter

Rotary Cutter Directions – yields (2) 12 ½” blocks

Corners: Cut (8) 3 ½” squares of light fabric

Flying Geese: Cut (2) 7 ½” squares of light fabric

Cut (8) 4” squares of dark*

Center: Cut (4) 4 ¼” squares of light*

Cut (2) 4 ½” squares of light*

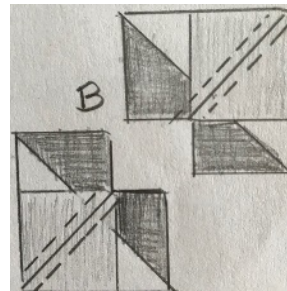
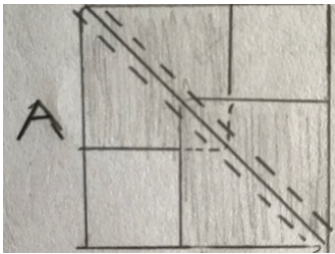
Cut (2) 4 ½” squares of medium

**Mark a diagonal on each starred square*

Flying geese:

Position (2) 4” squares on one 7 ½” square. Stitch ¼” on both sides of drawn diagonal.

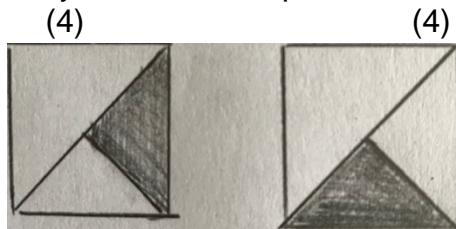
(Diagram A). Cut apart and press toward smaller triangles. Position one 4” square in corners of previously pieced units. Stitch ¼” on each side of marked diagonal. **(Diagram B)**. Cut apart. Repeat to get 4 more flying geese. Carefully trim to 3 ½” x 6 ½”.



Center:

Position (1) 4 ½” medium square with (1) 4 ½” light square and stitch ½” from both sides of marked diagonal. Cut apart and press to medium fabric. Position 4 ¼” light square with pieced half square triangle and stitch ¼” from both sides of marked diagonal. **(Diagram C)** Cut apart. Carefully trim to 3 ½” squares.
