

## 2021 PRESIDENT'S CHALLENGE

Exploring the Possibilities

Many traditional quilt blocks have been around for decades. And there are dozen we're all familiar with like Sun Bonnet Sue, log cabin and Dresden plate. Well, now's your chance to pick a traditional quilt pattern and see what it would look like in the 21st century!

Take your favorite quilt block and interpret it four ways. Use this challenge to expand and explore the design possibilities of a traditional block. Take a familiar block and how it is usually presented and make it into something entirely new. It may mean changing the setting, the colors or the form quilters are accustomed to seeing it in a quilt.

You must interpret the same block four ways and set it either in a square, horizontal or vertical format. Start with the traditional pattern and then go from there! Here's some ideas for other approaches you might take:

MODERNIZE IT
ADD EMBELLISHMENTS
CRAZY QUILT IT
FRACTURE THE BLOCK
WHAT IF IT WERE A COLLAGE?
DOES IT WORK IN REPETITION?
FUSE IN DIFFERENT MATERIALS
DO SOMETHING EXPERIMENTAL
DISTORT THE IMAGE
MAKE A DESIGN PROGRESSION
SIMPLIFY IT
COMPLICATE IT

Assemble your four, 12" blocks into a square or strung out lengthwise or vertically. The only restriction is that the original, traditional block, needs to be recognizable in some form in each panel.
